




The Annual Meeting is on

Oxford OX2 6HR**

The church is south of the west end of Canterbury Road, and opposite Leckford Road. The Centre was established in 1983, and exists to provide education for church leaders from the non-Western world.




Important information about our use of OCMS

SS Philip and James has a distinctive spire, so when you are near, you can't easily miss it!

Please note: there is no all-day parking at OCMS, but for FREE car parking nearby, see Option 5 below.

For the Annual Meeting, entry will be by the west door (see right).

If you are using a wheel chair, please help us and let us know – ramps can then be put in place to allow access throughout the building.



Several travel options are available for you:

1. By Train Option A: Use the main Oxford station (OX1 1HS) (*)

Once through the ticket barrier at Oxford station, you may like to consult the electronic screen showing the next bus to depart from outside the station.

a) Use Bus S3 (leaving from stop R5). It goes through the city centre and then along the Woodstock Road. You alight at Canterbury Road.

Walk a little way back down the Woodstock Road towards the city centre.

You will see OCMS on your left. Cross the road by the Pelican crossing.

b) Alternatively, use Bus 14 (to 'the John Radcliffe Hospital' - from stop R4).

This takes you up the Banbury Road (parallel to the Woodstock Road).

Alight at (the east-end of) Canterbury Road (NB: the stop is called 'Park Town'). Then walk a little way back towards the city centre and turn right into Canterbury Rd. ***Walk along Canterbury Road (the China Centre is on your right half way along) & turn left when you reach Woodstock Road. OCMS is on the left.***

2. **By Train Option B: Use Oxford Parkway station** (OX2 8HA)

Chiltern Railways run trains from London Marylebone to Oxford.

Get off at Oxford Parkway Station. Come out of the station, and bear right. Walk past the cycle racks and up the slope to the main road. Wait there for any of the buses to the city centre numbered 2, 2A, 2B, 2C or 2D. The bus will bring you down the Banbury Road, across the Ring Road, through the Summertown shops, and then your stop is preceded by Linton Road and St Margaret's Road stops). Alight at Park Town

Canterbury Road is opposite the Park Town bus stop.

So cross the Banbury Road by the Pelican crossing and take the 5 minute walk along Canterbury Road. The China Centre is on your right half way along. Turn left when you reach Woodstock Road and the entrance to OCMS is soon on your left.

3. **By Coach** Coaches arrive (from London and from many other locations nationwide) at Gloucester Green (which is to the west of the city centre OX1 2AQ).

From here you can take a taxi from outside the cinema, or

a) Take the S2 bus (at Bay 8) which goes along the Woodstock Road.

Alight at Canterbury Road.

Walk a little way back down the Woodstock Road towards the city centre.

You will see OCMS on your left. Cross the road by the Pelican crossing.

b) Enjoy a 25 minute walk. (Go east along Beaumont Street to the Ashmolean Museum / Randolph Hotel. Turn left into St Giles, and head north. St Giles church is in the fork between two main roads. Take the left fork up the Woodstock Road. You will find OCMS on the right after St Antony's College).

4. **By Car Option A: Pear Tree Park and Ride** (north of the City, OX2 8BF or OX2 8JD).

Pay £2 for parking; then catch the 300 bus (to 'City Centre and Redbridge').

This bus comes down the Woodstock Road. Alight at Canterbury Road. Continue walking in the direction the bus goes. Cross Canterbury Road and OCMS is soon on your left.

5. **By Car Option B: Free Parking at Wycliffe Hall.**

Park your car outside the brick buildings of Wycliffe Hall, 54 Banbury Road OX2 6PW.

Then walk back up the Banbury Road away from the city centre.

Cross the road at the Pelican Crossing, and then turn along Canterbury Road.

Walk along Canterbury Road (the China Centre is on your right half way along) & turn left when you reach Woodstock Road. OCMS is soon on your left.

(**) From the main railway station, there is also the option of taking a taxi (there are usually plenty of taxis outside the station). But you might enjoy a 30 minute walk. From the station, follow the pedestrian signs to the Oxford Canal. Head north away from the city centre ... (past St Barnabas church on your right, and past a footbridge with some boats moored nearby) ... until you get to Walton Well Road. Turn right (cross the canal by the road bridge), and then bear left at the well, and OCMS will be straight ahead (crossing one road by the Grog Shop, and continuing along Leckford Road).
