Peter wrote in September: "We have received 36 new students and have 68 students in total (It was 75 in 2020). I am invited to preach in some churches."

Prayer point: Many students in the Sichuan seminary come from ethnic minority backgrounds (eg Hani, Lahu, Jingpo, Han, Yi, Lisu and Miao). Also remember the Bible School in Guizhou. May the Lord sustain these places of learning to the blessing of the widely scattered urban and rural communities they serve.

Location 1: Wuhan, Hubei Province, Central China.

Person: Dr 'Jenny' Zhao Qiufen, Dean of Zhoongnan (Central South) seminary. Jenny was awarded her doctorate this year by Taiwan Baptist College. Her role entails the oversight of the academic



programmes.
